

Center for New Americans welcomes and serves immigrants, refugees, and asylum-seekers in Western Massachusetts, and has been a community resource center for immigrants for close to 30 years.

We teach free classes in English for Speakers of Other Languages, and offer instruction in technology and civics. We lead field trips, offer career guidance and training, and help immigrants to obtain jobs in healthcare and manufacturing. We offer citizenship application assistance and immigration legal services.

We have program sites in Amherst, Greenfield, and Northampton. We have a small, hard-working staff, many loyal volunteers, and a dedicated Board of Directors.

30 Poems in November! is the literary equivalent of a charity road race. People write and raise to support Center for New Americans' free classes and services for immigrants.

Sarah Sullivan served as Event Chair for her 4th year, offering daily poetry prompts and 2 writing workshops to support writers in their effort to write 30 poems and to build community.

Tzivia Gover and Nerissa Nields also offered writing workshops. Gri Saex created a writing community through Poesía Contigo for immigrants to write in their native languages and some of our staff and students wrote with her. Our students also wrote poetry in class guided by teachers who now rely on poetry as a vehicle for teaching. Our student, Bethie Jean Merci, served as our Student Spokesperson.

Our writers and their supporters raised \$85,000 which was matched by a challenge which will put us over \$100,000! This event is our Celebration of all this effort!.


